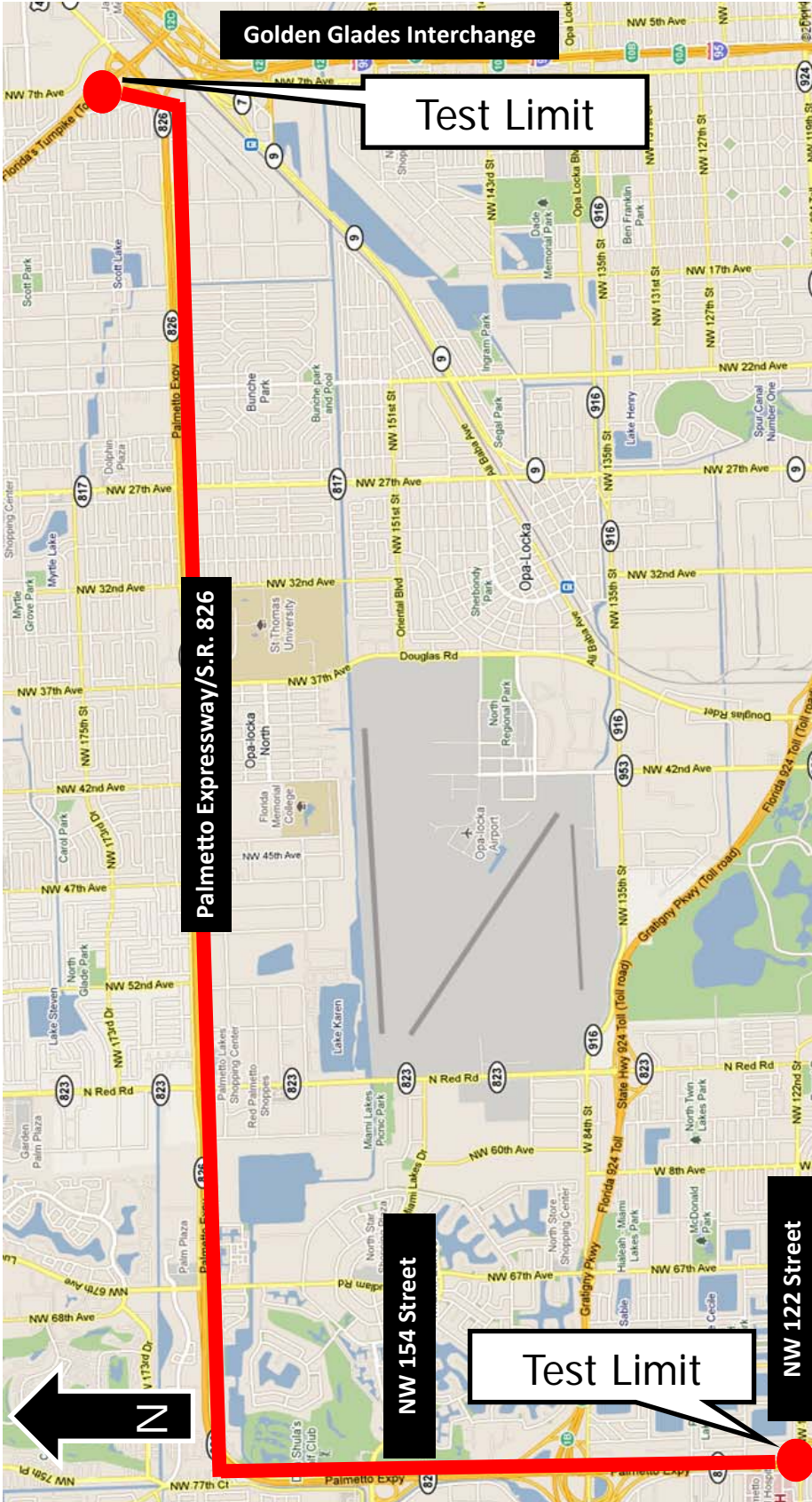

NATURAL GAS PIPELINE TEST BEGINS



Overview

On Wednesday, April 19, 2017, the Florida Gas Transmission Company will test 10.2 miles of natural gas pipeline using water. The pipeline runs primarily underneath the Palmetto Expressway/S.R. 826. The following closures will occur:

- Two eastbound lanes on S.R. 826 will be closed from NW 154 St. to the Golden Glades Interchange.
- Eastbound S.R. 826 on and off ramps will be closed from NW 67 Ave. to the Golden Glades Interchange.
- Eastbound S.R. 826 ramp to southbound I-95 and U.S. 441.
- Eastbound S.R. 826 ramp to eastbound NW 167 St. (S.R. 826/Beaches).
- Northbound I-95 ramp to westbound S.R. 826.
- Southbound Turnpike ramp to westbound S.R. 826.
- Northbound NW 57 Ave. at S.R. 826.
- Southbound NW 12 Ave. and northbound NW 13 Ave. at S.R. 826.

The test will take place one night from midnight to 4 a.m. If the test does not pass the first night, a second night of testing will be necessary.
